

Martinez Refinery

REFINERY INFORMATION

The Martinez Refinery is located in Martinez, California on 2,200 acres and has a crude oil capacity of 166,000 barrels per day (bpd). Using crude oils from California and other domestic and foreign sources, the refinery produces motor fuels, including cleaner-burning California Air Resources Board (CARB) gasoline and CARB diesel fuel, as well as conventional gasoline and diesel fuel. The refinery also produces heavy fuel oils, liquefied petroleum gas and petroleum coke. The Martinez Refinery receives crude oil by tanker through the San Francisco Bay at the Logistics LP Martinez marine terminal, a third party terminal in Martinez and third-party pipeline systems.

COMPANY PROFILE

Andeavor is a premier refining, marketing and logistics company in the western United States. Andeavor has 13,000 employees, operates 10 refineries with a combined capacity of approximately 1.2 million barrels per day, and has an extensive logistics network. 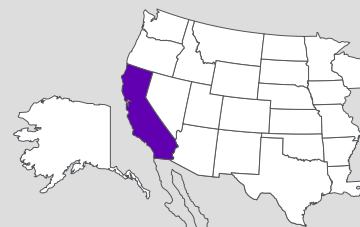
