

# Anacortes Refinery

## Fact Sheet



### REFINERY INFORMATION

Located about 70 miles north of Seattle on the picturesque Puget Sound, the Anacortes Refinery has a total crude-oil capacity of 120,000 barrels per day (bpd). The refinery primarily supplies gasoline, jet fuel and diesel fuel to markets in Washington and Oregon, and manufactures heavy fuel oils and liquefied petroleum gas. It receives crude feedstock via pipeline from Canada, by rail from North Dakota and the central U.S. and by tanker from Alaska and foreign sources.

The Anacortes Refinery ships gasoline, jet fuel and diesel fuel through a third-party pipeline system that serves western Washington and Oregon. The facility delivers refined products, including CARB gasoline and components for it, through our marine terminal, via ships and barges. Andeavor operates refined products terminals at Anacortes, Port Angeles and Vancouver, Washington.

### COMPANY PROFILE

Andeavor is a premier, highly integrated marketing, logistics and refining company. Our retail-marketing system includes more than 3,100 stores marketed under multiple well-known fuel brands. We have an extensive logistics network, and operate 10 refineries with a combined capacity of approximately 1.2 million barrels per day in the mid-continent and western United States. 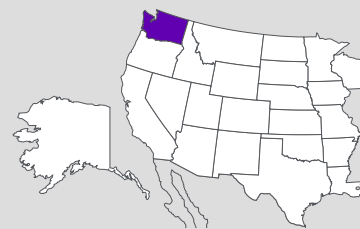
